This notice and the resource documents linked below have information about rights, options, and resources for members of the UCR community—including faculty, non-faculty academic personnel, staff, students, and third parties—who, according to information received by [UCR’s Office of Civil Rights \(“OCR”\)](#), may have experienced discrimination or harassment based on a Protected Category. ### What is a Protected Category?

- Race or color or ancestry (including caste and including perceived shared ancestral or ethnic characteristics)
- National or ethnic origin or religion
- Sex (including pregnancy, childbirth, lactation or related conditions), gender, gender identity, gender expression, gender transition, sexual orientation or marital status
- Disability, medical condition or predisposing genetic information
- Age (over 40) or veteran or military status.
